The codes to the key are located at the bottom of each form questionnaires.
 The letters are the abbreviations of the condition written backwards,
 e.g. DHDA = Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder
 The question numbers correlate to the disorder.

DP = Panic Disorder	Questions 4-16
PS = Specific phobias	Questions 17-20 (E.g., animals, social situations, school, fear of open spaces)
DAG = Generalized Anxiety Disorder	Questions 21-36
DCO = Obsessive Compulsive Disorder	Questions 37-50
8. DPB = Borderline Personality Disorder	Questions 1-37
NA = Anorexia Nervosa	Questions 38-48
9. HCS = Schizophrenia	Questions 1-35
NB = Bulimia Nervosa	Questions 36-49
